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PART-TIME STATUS: Information for Law Students

Due to certain circumstances, a student may wish to change their status in the JD or JD/JID program from full-time to part-time. The following policies deal with changes in enrollment status:

Full-time to part-time

A full-time student who has achieved standing in first year may apply to continue their studies as a part-time student. The Faculty may allow a limited number of these students to enroll as part-time students upon being satisfied that a student is unable to continue as a full-time student because of health or physical disability, or family or financial hardship.

Part-time to full-time

Once a part-time student has achieved standing in first year, they may request to become a full-time student.

Remaining part-time

After achieving standing in first year, part-time students must demonstrate to the Faculty at the beginning of each academic session that they continue to be unable to attend on a full-time basis because of health or physical disability, or exceptional family or financial hardships.
