

Neuroscience Program General Application Process

Begin the General Application Process by researching potential supervisors on the UVic Neuroscience Graduate Program website:

Contact prospective supervisor(s) by email to confirm a position is available. Attach your CV, transcripts, and two letters of reference to this email.

Once the potential supervisor confirms, initiate the formal application process with UVic's Faculty of Graduate Studies. Identify your home department as your primary supervisor's home department.

If no potential supervisors confirm by email a position is available, you will not be considered.

The Faculty of Graduate Studies will evaluate your application documents. If your application is approved, they will notify you by email. Your application documents are now forwarded to the Neuroscience Committee for review.

If the Faculty of Graduate Studies identifies any irregularities in your application, they will notify the Graduate Secretary. The supervisor and Graduate Secretary will contact you.

If the Committee approves your application and funding is in place, you will be admitted into the program. The Graduate Secretary will notify you by email.

If the committee declines your application, you will not be admitted to the program. The Graduate Secretary will notify you by email.
