

Health Insurance Overview





UVSS AND GSS EXTENDED HEALTH AND DENTAL BENEFIT PLANS

Dental, vision, and additional coverage to members of the UVic undergraduate (via Studentcare) and graduate (via Pacific Blue Cross) students' societies. Fees vary for UVSS/GSS and cover an entire academic year.

MTMI / guard.me

What is guard.me?

- Temporary primary health insurance for new international students
- Covers basic and emergency medical care, including dental emergencies
- Keeps you safe while you wait for MSP

Official coverage dates for Fall:

September 1 to December 31, 2024

Grace period:

August 18 to August 31

Paying MTMI Fees

MTMI fees are paid with your tuition

MTMI fee: <u>CAD \$265</u> charge added to your UVic Account Balance

Fee payment deadline: September 30, 2024 **Additional fees may be added if payment is late.*

Payment methods: Convera GlobalPay for students, international bank transfer/wire or debit (in office). See <u>paying your tuition fees</u> for options.





Using Your MTMI

Enrolment confirmation:

- Expect an email from guard.me to:
 - Set up your <u>online account</u>
 - Download a copy of your card
 - See policy details
 - Submit claims

*Check your spam/junk folders.

Healthcare Access Card:

- Your key to using your benefits.
- When getting medical care, bring:
 - Picture of Healthcare Access Card
 - Government issued ID
 - Student Card
 - Copy of study permit

Opting Out of MTMI

Opt-out if:

- You are already covered by BC MSP
- Have one of the eligible plans listed on the guard.me@UVic website

By September 22: 100% refund **After September 22:** may be eligible for partial refund

Pre-existing or chronic condition:

• email us at <u>icsinfo@uvic.ca</u> to confirm your eligibility and get appeal information





BC Medical Service Plan

Enrolment in British Columbia's Medical Service Plan (BC MSP) is mandatory for all BC residents.

Students staying in BC for **6 months or longer** who hold a valid study permit must apply.

<u>Apply online</u> for BC MSP as soon as you arrive in BC. Waiting period for coverage eligibility is 3 months from arrival month.

International Student Health Fee: CAD \$75/month (per person) payable to BC government's Revenue Services.

BC MSP Timeline

Steps to ensure you are covered:

- As soon as you arrive in BC: apply for MSP
- **3 months after you apply**: receive confirmation of enrolment + personal health number in the mail
- **4 months after you apply**: receive your Health Services card and payment information
- Monthly: pay your MSP fee

Important: your MSP expires when your study permit expires. If you have applied for a new study permit, you must update MSP to ensure continuous coverage.





Extended Health & Dental

What are extended benefits?

- Coverage for medical care not included in primary health insurance
- Subsidized by student union membership
- Important component of comprehensive and holistic medical care

Coverage includes:

- Dental care
- Vision Care
- Mental health: counselling, psychiatry, & more
- Physical health: chiropractic, acupuncture, physiotherapy, & more
- Gender affirming care



Extended Health & Dental

Most students are automatically enrolled and pay their fees via their UVic Account

Exchange students: who do not pay tuition to UVic are not automatically enrolled, but can opt-in with the <u>UVSS</u> or <u>GSS</u>.

Opting Out:

- Must have equivalent coverage (through family, spouse, or work)
- **Deadline:** September 22 (for fall term)

Dates:

- Sept 1, 2023 Aug 31, 2024
- Renews annually





Extended Health & Dental Undergraduate Students

Coverage for <u>undergraduate students</u> such as vision care, travel, dental, physiotherapy, massage, gender affirming care, as well as some medication coverage.

Provider: <u>studentcare</u> (Blue Cross) <u>Plan details here.</u>

Cost: \$367.41/ term

Extended Health & Dental Graduate Students

Coverage for <u>graduate students</u> such as dental, physiotherapy, massage, gender affirming care, as well as some medication coverage.

Cost: assessed per term + credits

How to get the most of your benefits:

- Familiarize yourself with the benefits available under your plan
- Learn about filing claims and using your benefits
- Ensure you have your plan information on hand
- Make sure you have MSP or MTMI

Policy ID: your UVic V# Group ID: UVSS: 3001 or GSS: 43222





Care for Dependents

Guard.me:

Ensure both you and your family have guard.me MTMI while waiting for MSP Purchase coverage for \$1.95/day using the online portal

MSP:

- Apply for MSP at the same time
- The \$75 fee is only for students; family members who are not students do not have to pay any fees for MSP

Extended health benefits:

- Optional to enroll your family, but advised.
- Opt-in your dependents by September 22
 with the UVSS or GSS



Health Insurance FAQ's

I don't have any health needs, do I need to have insurance?

• Yes! You never know what will happen or when you might get sick. Medical care in Canada is very expensive if you do not have insurance.

I want to save money, can I wait to apply for MSP?

- No. It is mandatory for British Columbians to have primary health insurance.
- Your guard.me expires after 4 months so you must apply for MSP as soon as you arrive in BC.

I have an extended health plan through my student union, can I opt-out of MSP?

• No. Primary and extended health care are different plans and cover different medical needs. Students must have both.



ACCESSING HEALTHCARE



Getting the Care You Need

Emergency care:

Hospital emergency room

General check-up or non-emergency care:

- Student Wellness Centre (at UVic)
- Walk-in Clinics
- Virtual care

Prescriptions:

- Nurse practitioner or a doctor
- For some medications, pharmacist can renew

Specialists:

• Obtain a referral from clinic or hospital

Medication questions:

Pharmacist



Accessing Healthcare

What to expect?

- Wait times vary
- Will be asked personal questions
- Privacy and confidentiality
- Can request gender of medical provider

Payments:

- **Billing at service** = pay when you are at doctor for services not covered
- An Invoice = you will have to pay the fee at a later time
- **Direct billing** = your insurance will be charged, you pay any difference
- **Out of pocket** = you will have to pay and submit a claim form via your insurance provider

- Insurance card:
 - Guard.me, or
 - BC Health Services Card
 - Personal Health Number
- Piece of ID (ONECard, BC ID)
- Study permit (a copy)
- Extended benefits policy and group #'s
- Emergency contact information




