


HEALTH INSURANCE OVERVIEW





Comprehensive Health Insurance




guard.me Information & Enrollment

- Mandatory for new international students
- Most international students are automatically enrolled upon course registration at UVic
- Health insurance intended to cover student's primary health expenses during waiting period for provincial plan
- Receive policy number and guard.me information by email
- Effective coverage December 18, 2021 April 30, 2022
- *Early arrival option for students arriving prior to December 18
- *Pre-existing conditions not covered

Opting out of guard.me

You may be eligible to opt out if you will be studying outside of Canada this term.

If you are inside Canada, you can opt out **only if** you are covered by one of the following:

- Valid BC MSP
- Canadian provincial or territorial public health plan
- Saudi Arabian Cultural Bureau-sponsored plan
- Libyan-North American Scholarship Program-sponsored plan
- African Leaders of Tomorrow Scholarship Program-sponsored plan
- Corbett British Columbia-Washington International Exchange & Fellowship Program

BC MSP

- BC MSP is mandatory for residents staying in BC for 6+ months, including international students
- Eligibility
- Coverage begins from the date approved and continues until the study permit expiry date – can be extended with updated study permit
- Current monthly health fees are \$75 CAD per month, per student (<u>BC MSP website</u>)
- Understanding your coverage is essential!

guard.me policy for COVID-19

- Students who contract COVID-19 are eligible to submit insurance
- Coverage does not include costs associated with selfisolation
- COVID-19 testing will likely be eligible for reimbursement if accompanied by a doctor's note requesting testing
- Medically necessary treatments for new and emergent conditions are eligible if it is prescribed by a certified health professional
