4. Changing a course from credit to audit is not permitted after the Academic Drop Deadline.
5. Once a course had been audited, the course is not open to course challenge.
6. Graduate courses are normally open only to students who are registered in the Faculty of Graduate Studies; see the faculty regulations in the UVic Graduate Calendar.
