



STUDENT REGISTRATION TUTORIAL: HOW TO REGISTER FOR CO-REQUISITE COURSES

Corequisite courses

- Certain courses in the UVic calendar hold “corequisite” registration restrictions which means that they must be taken in conjunction with a second course.
- The registration process for these courses is slightly unique and failure to follow the steps correctly will result in an Add/Drop Error that will not allow you to add the course(s) to your timetable.
- If you are unsure if your course has a corequisite requirement, contact your department or your academic adviser.

MATH 342

Intermediate Ordinary Differential Equations

Units: 1.5, Hours: 3-0

Informal discussion of the Picard-Lindelöf and Peano existence theorems, series solutions near ordinary and regular singular points, Frobenius method, systems of first order linear equations, complex and repeated eigenvalues, nonhomogeneous linear systems, advanced numerical methods (implicit, multi-step), stability and bifurcation theory, other qualitative methods.

Note: Credit will be granted for only one of [342](#), 323, 323A, 325.

Formerly: 325

Prerequisites: [200](#) and [201](#); one of [110](#), 133, [211](#), 233A; or equivalent.


