The technician will work with a Senior Lab Instructor and Scientific Technician to help prepare the material needed for the Techniques in Molecular Biology course (Biology 362). Duties will involve preparing chemicals, setting up equipment, preparing bacterial cultures, cleaning glassware, DNA extraction, PCR, gel electrophoresis, restriction enzyme digestion, cloning, transformation, colony hybridizations, and sequencing (*i.e.* the technician will test all lab experiments). The lab assistant will also help set up, maintain and clean the Biology 362 laboratory. Applicants need to be available to start early December.
