JOB DESCRIPTION:

Student will work in a micropaleontology research group dealing with evolution, past examples of climate change, and microfossils. Student will primarily be assisting in data entry for a large database project ([eODP](#)), entering taxonomic information, ages of marine sediments from scientific ocean drilling sites, and other data-entry work. Work on that project is highly flexible to student schedule and location. Dependent on COVID restrictions and/or student-worker interest, there is a potential for the student to be involved in various projects, ranging from sediment processing, laboratory organization, and others. Student can expect weekly or every-2-week meetings via Zoom or in-person, again depending on COVID situation.
