Applicants MUST meet basic eligibility requirements of the IPSFC Program. Check your eligibility requirements before filling out the application form.

There are 6 graduate student scholarships and 14 faculty, post-doc fellowships to be completed by March 2028. For all applications, the minimum in-region requirement must be met by March 2028 (120 days for scholarships and 90 days for fellowships) and all deliverables completed.

Complete application packages for second-round competition must be submitted by 24 June 2026 **Subsequent rounds of applications will be reviewed on a bi-monthly basis. Once all the scholarships and fellowships have been awarded, the application portal will be closed.**
