


# **Public Lecture** Friday, Nov 3

## Dan Stone

The Holocaust is muchdiscussed, much-memorialized and portrayed in fiction. But major parts of its history have still not been understood. Drawing on his new book The Holocaust: An Unfinished *History*, Dan Stone focuses on: the need to understand the significance of Nazism's genocidal ideology; why the Holocaust is not synonymous with the history of the Nazi concentration camps; the shortcomings of the commonly heard concept of "industrial genocide"; and the fact that the genocide of the Jews required continent-wide collaboration.
