Currently my focus is on Talmudic understandings of borders (*G'vul* in Hebrew) and how Rabbinic discussions organise people and territory, as well as activities across space on Sabbath. In particular, I am studying whether there are *other* than social scientific ways of thinking about human relationships (people, communities) with territory thanks to borders.
