## Beyond Food Fights: Religion, Food, Power and Politics

Food is always and inevitably political. It should come as no surprise, then, that food is taking up an increasingly important place in political discourses of inclusion and exclusion, as well as the management of religious diversity. In this talk I will explore the ways that, in various countries, food acts as a new battleground on which the idea of "who is an acceptable citizen" is fought and the ways this plays into the building, and critiquing of, the "nation".

Rachel Brown is Director of the Centre for Studies in Religion and Society and Assistant Teaching Professor in Anthropology and Religion, Culture and Society at UVic. Rachel's current research focuses on food and migration/minorities, Muslim integration, and lived religion.
