On *Día de Muertos*—“Day of the Dead”—the CSRS will host an open conversation about death and dying. This special event will feature a panel of experienced professionals who regularly encounter death and wrestle with its implications for the living. Those who are grieving often do not have the language to describe what is happening to them. They may have thoughts on the soul, heaven, guilt, fear, dread, relief, etc. that surprise them. A normalizing discussion of death and dying will help citizens prepare for and deal with their thoughts, feelings and actions when a close person dies.
