UVic Graduate Student Fellowship Application

2025/2026

The Centre for Global Studies is pleased to offer graduate student fellowship opportunities. The CFGS invites applications from UVic graduate students for fellowship appointments at the centre **September 1, 2025 - August 31, 2026**.

These fellowships support students in the research stages of their program. In addition to these funds, the fellowships provide students with a title, a shared office, an opportunity to provide a public lecture based on their research, opportunities to work on the projects housed in the CFGS, and regular opportunities to meet other students and professors interested in related issues.

Topics: The CFGS promotes critical citizenship in a complex and rapidly changing global environment including the advancement and understanding of major global issues by civil society, the private sector, governments, and international institutions. Students are invited to apply who are engaged in similar topics of a global dimension. These topics may include, but are not limited to: global governance, international environmental challenges, social and ecological justice issues, and culture and identity. Applications from all disciplinary backgrounds are welcome.

Eligibility: The fellowships are open to all University of Victoria graduate students in the process of writing either a master's thesis or major research paper, or a PhD dissertation, on issues related to the centre's research mandate. Students may receive a CFGS award only once during their master's program and once during their PhD program.

Value: \$5,000 per fellowship, plus office space at the CFGS.

Conditions: Ordinarily, fellows are expected to stay for at least 2 academic terms up to a maximum of 12 months and are expected to conduct their work in the centre's quarters, to participate actively in the programs and activities of the centre, and to give at least one public seminar or lecture on the theme of their research.

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Application Procedure: Applications should include each of the following:

a completed application form, which includes:

- a descriptive title that clearly identifies the subject of the project (approx. 100 words).

- a brief description of how your research speaks to or fits within the field of Global Studies (approx. 250 words)

- a brief description of how this interdisciplinary community will benefit from your research and how you hope to benefit from this community (approx. 100 words).

- a concise summary of the research proposal/project objectives and methodology in a form that is directed to an interdisciplinary review committee (approx. 500 words).

a curriculum vitae

a copy of transcripts both graduate and undergraduate (official transcripts may be requested if candidate is short listed)

a supporting letter from the applicant's supervisor

a letter of support from another professor or former professor of the candidate
(original mailed or directly emailed to cfigs@uvic.ca)
