




The Empire and Campaigns of Genghis Khan

The Mongol empire – Post-Chinggis Khan




Mongol conquests





Estimated ontological status of PLPD institutions


Human population expansion, 10,000 BC- 2000 AD




Chinggis Khan's lifespan & global averages


Growth in human security, 10,000 BC to 2000 AD



How Chinggis Khan lived to the ripe old age of 62(+/-)




The perilous life of Chinggis Khan – An actuarial estimation/risk analysis

Constructing the Theory of

Anthrocentric Security

Anthrocentric Security inputs:

Individual level

- 1/. Will and physical capacity to survive [Wi].
 Staying alive is the first law of nature.
 (Schopenhauer "Will-to-Live")
- * 2/. Family, pre-adolescent inputs[F] including the reproductive, nurturing and protective inputs of family.
- * 3/. Knowledge [Ki], both innate instinct and acquired knowledge, enables individuals and families to obtain food, water and shelter to sustain life
- × 4/. Natural environment [Ei] provides the means and materials for survival.

Anthrocentric Security inputs:

Organic society level

- 5/. The liberty [Ls] of action one individual acquires (and surrenders) with membership (personhood) in society.
- 6/. Access to socially-generated cultural and technical knowledge [Ks].
- 7/. Obligation/loyalty to other persons in a social network [Os].
- 8/. The benefits of a social economy [Es].
- 9/. The average effects of the social concord coefficient [SC].

Anthrocentric Security inputs: State level

- 10/. Increasing the intensity and scope of obligations of each person to the State [Op]
- 11/. Performance of the political economy [Ep].
- 12/. Specialized, usually esoteric, political knowledge [Kp] drawn from experience and history, and utilized for the establishment, preservation and expansion of State power.
- 13/. The coercive institutions of the State primarily the military [M] to defend it against external enemies and internal disorder and rebellions.
- 14/. The coefficient of (domestic) political concord [PC].
- 15/. External relations [ER] may be either positive or negative in political concord their effect on actual sovereignty.

Anthrocentric Security of one person in organic society


