DIRECTOR SEARCH Centre for Global Studies

Nominations and applications are invited for the position of Director of the Centre for Global Studies. The appointment is expected to begin 1 August 2013 for a five-year term. The search is open to faculty members who hold a tenured appointment at the rank of Associate Professor or Professor at the University of Victoria. Reporting to the Vice-President Research, the Director will lead and provide strategic direction for the Centre and its programs. The Director is eligible for teaching release and an administrative stipend.

Applicants should possess and demonstrate the following attributes:

- a record of academic excellence as a scholar in a field of endeavor related to global studies;
- a broad knowledge of global studies;
- ability to maintain and develop a network of colleagues and resources;
- demonstrated (or demonstrated potential) administrative, organizational and management skills;
- a breadth of vision for global studies;
- the capacity to build consensus;
- demonstrated record of raising funds from external agencies; and
- commitment to knowledge mobilization and to disseminating the achievements of the Centre.

Since its formal inception in 1998 The Centre for Global Studies (CFGS) has had a mandate to conduct collaborative, interdisciplinary and cross-regional inquiry into the impacts of globalization. The Centre's activities in Victoria, Canada, and abroad are designed to promote critical citizenship in a complex and rapidly changing global environment. CFGS research and public engagement build upon the University of Victoria's intellectual expertise in four core themes: governance, environmental challenges, social justice, and culture and identity.
