## Visiting Researcher Fellowship Application

### 2026/2027

The Centre for Global Studies is pleased to offer visiting researchers fellowship opportunities. The CFGS invites applications from scholars in Canada or abroad for visiting fellowship appointments at the centre **July 2025 through June 2026 arrival\***.

**Purpose:** The purpose of the fellowship is to provide research space and an environment conducive to writing and reflection to scholars working on research projects in the area of global studies.

**Topics:** The CFGS promotes critical citizenship in a complex and rapidly changing global environment including the advancement and understanding of major global issues by civil society, the private sector, governments, and international institutions. Students are invited to apply who are engaged in similar topics of a global dimension. These topics may include, but are not limited to: global governance, international environmental challenges, ecological and social justice issues, and culture and identity. Applications from all disciplinary backgrounds are welcome.

**Value:** Office space centrally located on the scenic University of Victoria campus; a congenial, retreat-like setting; university privileges; enhanced opportunities for research networking and exchange; participation in the centre's wide range of scholarly and social activities.

Applicants may be eligible for a travel bursary of up to \$1500 CAD. Otherwise this is a non-stipendiary appointment, with no cash value. Successful applicants must secure their own research funding to cover other costs associated with visa applications, health insurance, and accommodations.

**Eligibility:** The fellowships are open to Canadian and international scholars; emeritus scholars; new scholars; scholars on sabbatical leave from their regular academic appointments. Consideration will also be given to professionals in NGOs and other related fields.

**Conditions:** Fellows are encouraged to stay between 3 months to 12 months, but the Centre will consider requests for research terms of any length. Successful applicants will:

- consider the Centre their primary office and conduct their work in the centre's quarters
- participate actively in the programs and activities of the Centre
- give at least one public seminar or lecture on the theme of their research
- acknowledge the CFGS in all publications arising from the fellowship and notify the Centre of any such presentations, books or articles for inclusion in our database.

    - ☐ a descriptive title that clearly identifies the subject of the project (approx. 100 words).
    - ☐ a concise summary of the research proposal/project objectives and methodology in a form that is directed to an interdisciplinary review committee (approx. 500 words).
    - ☐ a brief description of how your research speaks to or fits within the field of Global Studies (approx. 250 words).
    - ☐ a brief description of how this interdisciplinary community will benefit from your research and how you hope to benefit from this community (approx. 100 words).
    - ☐ the names and full addresses of two (2) scholars who might evaluate the proposed project including institutional affiliation & relationship to applicant. The centre may also choose to solicit the opinions of other referees.
  - ☐ an up-to-date curriculum vitae
