Young Adult Advisory Council (YAAC)!

Criteria for applying:

- Must be between the ages of 19-25.
- Being comfortable in a roundtable dialogue-based environment.
- Passion for youth-driven solutions to current issues.
- Previous participation in youth-led activities in their school or community is an asset.

Duties and responsibilities:

- Attendance and active participation at council meetings.
- Respecting the various opinions, backgrounds, values, identities and beliefs of the rest of the council.
- Engaging with the conversation topics to turn discussion into ideas of tangible action.
- Contributing your unique skillset to the council's committees and projects.

CFYS will offer an honorarium following the completion of each six-month term and all of the above duties and responsibilities. The monthly time commitment will be approximately 5 hours.

This initiative will bring together passion-driven young people aged 19-25 to discuss the issues they and other young people face and brainstorm responses to inform the CFYS and partners on youth's emerging priorities.

The council meets monthly, on Zoom or in-person at the University of Victoria (on a rotating schedule).

Each candidate will be expected to be available for all meetings, to the best of their ability, until December 2022. There will be the option of renewal for additional terms.
