The Award

The purpose of this Award is to provide support to graduate students in the Centre for Youth and Society whose research and/or practice contributes to youth well-being through a community event, workshop or youth-led project. Preference will be given to students who have overcome adversity in their own lives to pursue their education at UVic. This may include but is not limited to, perseverance and courage in the face of obstacles, learning or physical disabilities, economic stresses, balancing education with employment, family responsibilities, or health issues.

Eligibility

Applicants must be graduate students at the University of Victoria. Applicants should have a background that demonstrates their commitment to, and compassion for, youth through community leadership, creativity, mental health practice, or volunteerism. The project should be in collaboration with a community partner. If you do not already have a community partner, the Centre can help you find one. Preference will be given to students who are Student Affiliate members of the Centre for Youth and Society.

Value

The recipient will be awarded **\$1,500** to realize their youth-related event or workshop. The recipient is also offered on-campus workspace in University House 3 with access to a mailbox, scanner and photocopier services (for the duration of the project).

Submission Deadline

Review of applications will begin on Monday March 20th, 2023 (4:00pm).
