The Award

Dr. Myer Horowitz is a founding member of the Centre for Youth and Society and Past Chair of the Advisory Board. The Myer Horowitz Endowment Fund reflects his commitment to enriching graduate student training and creating opportunities for learning outside of the university setting and across disciplines. The award can be used for students as support for their community-based research.

Eligibility

Applicants must be graduate students at the University of Victoria. Preference will be given to students who are Student Affiliate members of the Centre for Youth and Society. The research project should consider issues related to children and youth (12 to 30 years of age), and be in collaboration with a community partner. If you do not already have a community partner, the Centre can help you find one.

Value

Recipients will be awarded **\$500** each towards their community-based research. Recipients are also offered on-campus work space in University House 3 with access to a mailbox, scanner and photocopier services (for the duration of the project).

Submission Deadline

CFYS will review submissions as they arrive. Applications will be accepted for review until Monday March 20th, 2023 (4:00pm).
