“Decolonizing and Indigenizing Music
Education” | Dr. Anita Prest, Associate Professor
of Music Education

In this presentation, Dr. Prest will describe a current, SSHRC PDG-funded, Indigenous-led study, entitled “From policy to practice in decolonizing and Indigenizing music education: Ensuring teacher understanding of Indigenous worldviews.” Dr. Prest will outline the partners involved in the study, their use of conference as research method, the Indigenous-led process in creating the conference, and the conference particulars. The purpose of the conference is to stimulate a province-wide conversation on how to embed Indigenous ways of knowing and being in music education classes as recommended in the BC curriculum in a way that is culturally appropriate to each location.
