

ROB AND TAMMY LIPSON RESEARCH SCHOLARSHIP

TERMS OF REFERENCE

What is the Rob and Tammy Lipson Research Scholarship?

The Rob and Tammy Lipson Research Scholarship was established by Rob Lipson, Dean of the Faculty of Science (2010-2019) and his wife, Tammy Lipson. Through this scholarship they want to help more students gain international research experience.

Who is eligible for an award?

All Science students who have an international research experience opportunity are welcome to apply.

Preference is given to academically outstanding undergraduate or graduate students who have demonstrated a commitment to knowledge translation through one of:

- a) A presentation at a departmental or research centre symposium or colloquium;
- b) Participation in a faculty/UVic presentation event, such as Honours Fest, Ideas Fest or JCURA; or
- c) A presentation at an external conference.

To be eligible for a Rob and Tammy Lipson Research Scholarship a student at the time of application must:

Undergraduate Students

- Be registered as a full-time student (12 units or higher) for a bachelor's degree in the Faculty of Science at the University of Victoria in the current Winter Session (September-April)
- Intend to continue in full-time undergraduate studies in the next Winter Session (September-April)
- Have a cumulative GPA of 6.0 or higher for all courses completed at the time of application

Graduate Students:

- Be registered as a full-time student (3.0 units or higher) for a master's degree or doctoral program
- Have a cumulative GPA of 7.0 or higher for all courses completed at the time of application

Value of awards

One or more scholarships valued between \$2,000 and \$4,000 are awarded annually.

How are students selected for the award?

Applications will be adjudicated by the Research Advisory Committee of the Faculty of Science. Students will be evaluated based on academic excellence (50%) and the strength of the collaborative research opportunity (50%). *Graduate students will be evaluated on the anticipated impact the opportunity will have on their research.*

Previous winners and new applicants will be assessed equally.

How and when do you apply?

To apply for this award, students must complete and submit the following documents to the Office of the Dean of Science by email to **scieoff@uvic.ca** by **April 30th**. <u>No</u> <u>handwritten applications will be accepted</u>.

- 1) The Rob and Tammy Lipson Research Scholarship application form
- 2) Itemized list of travel and expenses related to presentation including documentation of other funding support
- 3) Letter of support from UVic advisor and/or departmental Chair or Director
- 4) Letter of support from international research supervisors
- 5) A CV (maximum 2 pages, 11-12pt font, single spaced) including:
 - Education
 - Relevant research/work experience
 - Awards and honours
 - List of peer-reviewed journal articles with full citation (published or accepted)
 - Submitted journal articles with full citation (include arXiv link or manuscript ID)
 - Other published works or patents
 - Presentations (full description including title, date, organization/venue)
 - Other relevant information

The letters of support from the UVic and International research supervisors should outline the nature of their collaboration, provide a brief summary of the proposed research, and a statement about the level of financial support they are providing towards living and/or travel expenses. The intention of the award is that the UVic advisor will be engaged in the research; however, there may be circumstances where the advisor may be unable to provide financial support, or the department is providing the financial support. In these circumstances, a letter of support from the department Chair/Director will be accepted.

Students who held the award in the previous academic year must submit a new application to be considered for an additional award.

- b) Who have been recommended by their Advisor and/or Department Chair; and
- c) Whose advisor/chair and international collaborator have both committed funding to the students' research opportunity.
