
## BIOCHEMISTRY AND MICROBIOLOGY (BCMB) Application Procedures for BCMB 499A/B (Honours)

## **Requirements**

- Completion of 3<sup>rd</sup> year <u>and a cumulative GPA of 6.0 (B+) in BCMB</u> 301A/B, BIOC 300A/B, MICR 302, and MICR 303. Of these, no single course can have a grade below 5.0 (B).
- 2. Declaration of an academic program in Biochemistry or Microbiology through the Academic Advising Centre via "My Page".
- 3. Registration in a minimum of 6 units (4 courses) per term. This includes BCMB 499A or B.
- 4. Permission of the Department.

## Application and Registration Procedures (assuming a Sept start date)



- Complete Part A of the <u>Research proposal form</u> to express your interest in the BCMB Honours Program and submit to the BCMB office (Petch 207) or via email to biocmicr@uvic.ca. This is normally completed by January of your 3<sup>rd</sup> year. You do not have to have a supervisor to complete this step.
- Contact a BCMB professor with whom you would like to study to discuss availability and proposed project ideas. Faculty profiles, research interests, and contact information can be found <u>here</u>. The Honours Advisor may also assist in matching up students with potential supervisors.

- Once a BCMB faculty member has agreed to supervise you for your Honours thesis, the two of you will complete the <u>research</u> <u>proposal form</u> and submit it to the BCMB office or email <u>biocmicr@uvic.ca</u> by July 31<sup>st</sup> for approval.
- 4. Once approved, you will receive an email that a department permission override will allow registration in BCMB499A/B.
- 5. You will be given instructions on how to request the Honours designation on your student record.
- 6. There are additional 4<sup>th</sup> year course requirements for the Honours program. Check the undergraduate academic calendar to ensure you will be completing all of the courses required for your Honours designation.
