The successful applicant must be available weekday mornings and Friday afternoons.				
REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS AND EXPERIENCE: Candidates must have completed BCMB 406A and B, or have equivalent laboratory experience (i.e. bacterial culture, PCR, DNA cloning, protein analysis, expression & purification, sterile technique). The successful candidate will also possess good communication, time-management, and organizational skills as well as the ability to follow protocols and work independently. Cell culture experience would be an asset. There is some flexibility in how the part time hours are worked but typically hours are worked in the morning between 9am - 1pm Monday through Thursday with a longer shift on Fridays.
