



Assistant Professor of Organic Chemistry

The Department of Chemistry at the University of Victoria invites applications for a tenure-track Assistant Professor position with expertise in the area of Organic Chemistry. The successful candidate will be responsible for developing a research program of international stature and teaching organic chemistry courses at all levels. In addition to this position, the Department has advertised a position for an Assistant Teaching Professor in Organic Chemistry.

- Be an effective teacher of chemistry, as evidenced by evaluation data, testimonials and other documentation.

- a concise research proposal (5 pages, NSERC Discovery Grant format preferred),
- a teaching dossier (including a teaching philosophy) that reflects a commitment to teaching,
