

School of Molecular Life Sciences Appointment Priority Policy for Specialist Instructional (CUPE 4163) Positions

The School of Molecular Life Sciences Graduate Program normally requires Masters students to complete 3 teaching assistant assignments (a total of 3 lab sections) and PhD students to complete 4 during their Graduate degree. Specialist Instructional (CUPE 4163) Positions are therefore assigned to graduate students within the School of Molecular Life Sciences as described below.

Appointment Priority Policy – School of Molecular Life Sciences (MLSC)

1. MLSC graduate students previously appointed to a bargaining unit position who have not fulfilled the TA component of their program.
2. MLSC graduate students not previously appointed.
3. MLSC graduate students who have fulfilled the TA component of their program.
4. Other qualified graduate students (including those in other Academic Units).
5. Qualified undergraduates.
6. Others/non-students.
