FACULTY & UNIVERSITY REQUIREMENTS

In addition to the listed courses, you must satisfy all **requirements for the Faculty of Science**, as well as complete at least 30 of the minimum 60 required units at UVic. Within these 60 units, 21 units must be upper-level (300/400-level) courses, and 18 of those 21 units must be taken at UVic.

ACADEMIC WRITING REQUIREMENT (AWR)

If you have not already satisfied UVic's **Academic Writing Requirement (AWR)**, you will need to complete one of ATWP 135, ENGL 135, 146, 147, or another approved course. If you have already satisfied the AWR on admission, you can instead select 1.5 units of electives.
