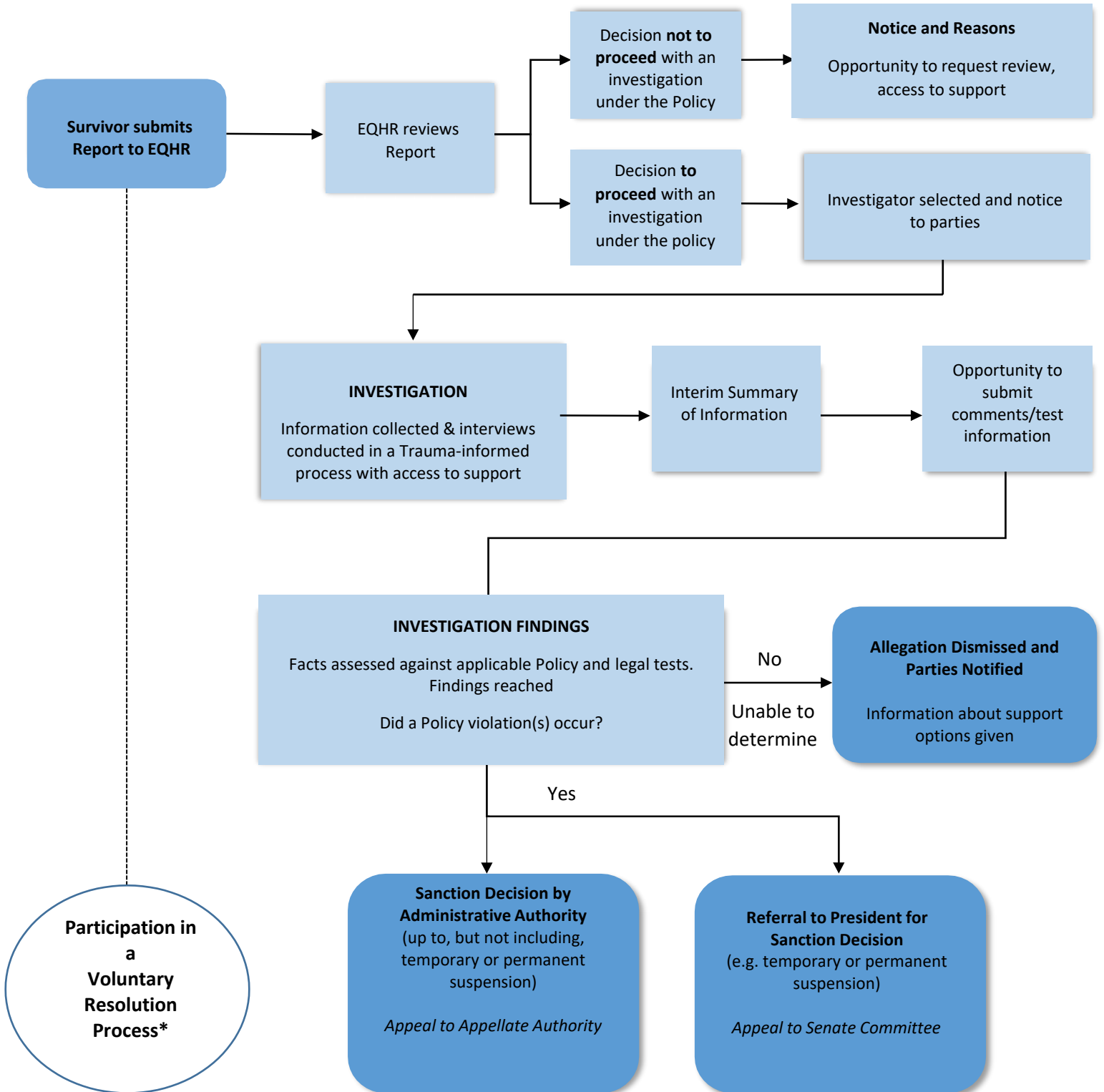

Get Information and Support

Support is available at all stages of the process

The Sexualized Violence Resource Office (“SVRO”) in the Equity and Human Rights Office (“EQHR”) was established by the University of Victoria (the “University”) to serve as the main point of contact for students, staff, faculty and librarians impacted by Sexualized Violence.

The SVRO provides information about the Sexualized Violence Prevention and Response Policy (GV0245 – the “Policy”), supports and services on and off campus, and a place where people can make Disclosures and/or Reports of Sexualized Violence.

The SVRO is committed to ensuring that the University Community responds to incidents of Sexualized Violence in a Trauma-informed and Survivor-centred manner. This includes ensuring that all people, regardless of their sex, gender, sexual orientation, racial or ethnic background, religious affiliation, immigrant status, socio-economic status, ability status, and position within the University structure, can access meaningful information and support.

To make a report, contact the SVRO in EQHR. We will explain the options available to you. You are welcome to bring a support person to any meeting. In the case of faculty or staff, you can also contact your supervisor or union.
