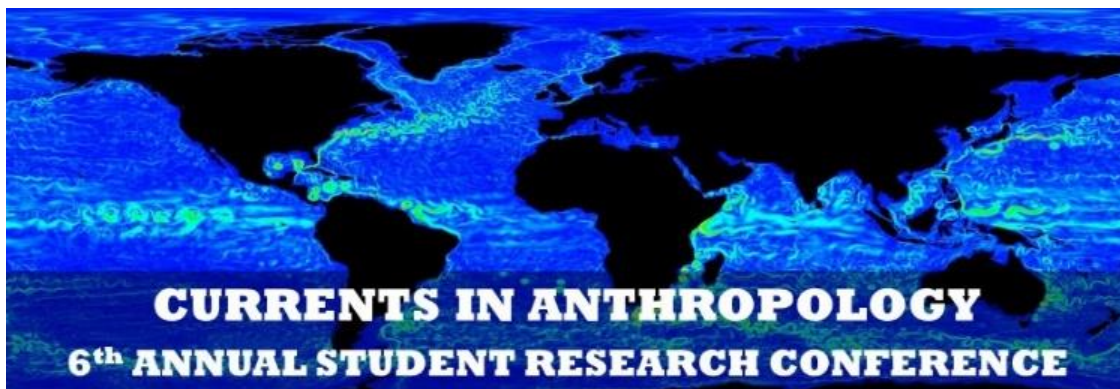


Important Academic Dates

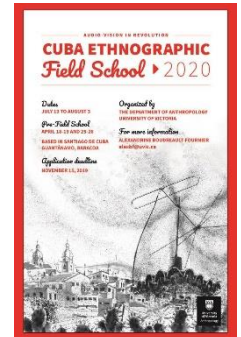
