## ETHNO-GRAPHIC NOVELS

### **COURSE DESCRIPTION AND OBJECTIVES**

An applied graphic anthropology course that focuses on drawing as an ethnographic research method. We will explore graphic anthropology as a form of knowledge transfer. Students will work towards creating an original graphic story based on their independent research. We will integrate 2 graphic novels into the class discussions. In-person classes meet Mondays and Wednesdays 1-4:20 pm in the Visual Research Lab in the Department of Anthropology. Each Friday students will meet at a location around the university or in the city of Victoria for an outside art-based research drawing lab. All locations accessible via public transit or walking from the Cornett Building on campus. Previous arts experience not required. Prerequisite: 2nd year standing.
