**Job Summary**

Located in Victoria, British Columbia close to Vancouver and Seattle, the Department of Psychology at the University of Victoria invites applications for a tenure-track appointment at the Assistant Professor level in Clinical Psychology. We are seeking candidates who have training, experience, and interest in teaching and supervising psychological assessments (e.g., psychosocial, psychoeducational, psychodiagnostic). Any area of research expertise is welcome. The position will contribute to our CPA-accredited Graduate Program in Clinical Psychology and to the UVic Department of Psychology more generally. The position begins on July 1, 2020.

**Qualifications**

Candidates must have a PhD in Psychology from a CPA- or APA-accredited program and must have completed a 12-month CPA- or APA-accredited internship. Applicants must be eligible for registration as a Psychologist in British Columbia. If not presently registered, the successful candidate will be expected to apply for registration as soon as possible after they are hired.

Candidates must demonstrate potential for research excellence as evidenced by publications (and/or other means of sharing research findings) and grant funding appropriate to level of experience. Applicants must also present evidence for potential excellence in teaching diverse students at the graduate and undergraduate levels. Candidates must have an interest and ability to teach graduate courses in some of the following areas: clinical assessment, psychometrics, professional ethics, and/or research methods. Candidates whose research and clinical activities contribute to our understanding of diverse populations are particularly encouraged to apply.

**Clinical Psychology Program**

We are seeking candidates with the ability to contribute actively to the operation of our Clinical Psychology Graduate Program (<http://www.uvic.ca/socialsciences/psychology/graduate/clinical-psychology>). Our program has been accredited continuously since its inception. We offer two specialty tracks within clinical psychology: clinical lifespan development and clinical neuropsychology. Students and faculty from across the two tracks learn from each other in a collegial environment.
