<sup>1</sup> CSC 105 is intended primarily for students in Economics or the School of Business; For Honours, we recommend CSC 110 or 111.

<sup>2</sup> To satisfy UVic's Academic Writing Requirement, complete one of ATWP 135 (formerly ENGL 135), ENGL 146, ENGL 147 or another approved course.

<sup>3</sup> The Mathematics requirement can also be satisfied by the completion of MATH 100 or 109, 101, 200 and 211 or 110 (6.0 units in total). Students in the BSc program are strongly recommended to take MATH 100 or 109, rather than MATH 102. Mathematics requirements should normally be completed by the end of Year 2.

<sup>4</sup> A course in statistics or quantitative methods will not count toward this requirement.

<sup>5</sup> ECON 365 and 366, and ECON 350 and 351 must be completed by the end of Year 3. ECON 365 has the following prerequisites: a minimum grade of B in MATH 208; or MATH 101 and 110 or 211.

<sup>6</sup> With permission of the department, a maximum of 6 units of courses numbered 300 and above in Mathematics, Computer Science or Statistics may be substituted for Economics courses numbered 300 and above.

<sup>7</sup> ECON 225 should normally be completed by the end of Year 2 and is a pre- or corequisite for many 300-level courses and all 400 level courses.

<sup>8</sup> Transfer students are encouraged to enrol in ECON 313 as soon as possible.
