## 1 Participate in an international exchange

Pay UVic tuition fees while taking courses at one of UVic's partner institutions throughout the world.

- Course credit **will** count towards UVic residency requirements
- Apply online by **February 1** (for September) or **August 1** (for January)

## 2 Study on a Letter of Permission

Take courses at any accredited institution and receive confirmation of course eligibility and UVic credit you will receive.

- Course credit **will not** count towards UVic residency requirements
- Requests must be submitted before you begin courses and at least eight weeks in advance for international institutions
- Talk to an academic adviser for more information, and submit your request to the **Academic Advising Centre**
