

Geomorphology and Chronology Lab: Laboratory Assistant Position

We seek a qualified individual to assist with 3D printing, laboratory work, and data synthesis in the Geomorphology and Chronology Research (GCR) Lab, which is focused on ongoing research into glacial environments.

This is a grant-paid, limited-term position. A 40-hr commitment per week is required. The work will be completed at the University of Victoria, Geography Department. The term is four months, **beginning May 1st** or as soon as possible. Salary will be on an hourly basis, with a rate that depends on experience, starting at **\$28/hr**. This is an excellent position for a recent graduate. This position would be partly funded by the Science Horizon Program; to meet these program requirements candidates must be between 15-30 years old and have Canadian citizenship, Canadian permanent residency status, or Canadian refugee status.

Applicants should have completed an undergraduate degree in Geography or Geoscience and have experience using Geographic Information Systems (GIS).
