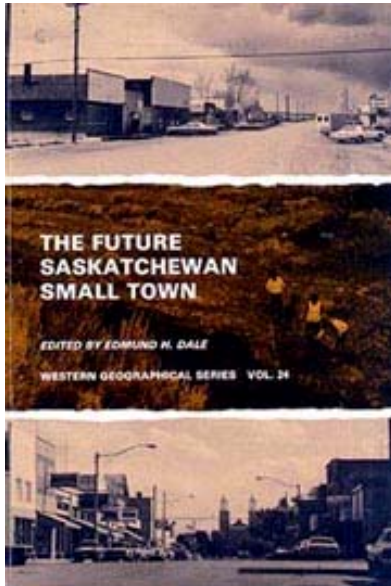


Volume 24 The Future Saskatchewan Small Town
