Undergraduate Grants Program

The Department of Geography, through the generosity of Dr. William Ross, has designated funds in support of travel for research or conferences on geographical topics by undergraduate students.

The following priorities for funding have been established:

1. Support of travel for research undertaken by undergraduate students who are enrolled in the Department of Geography and involved in unpaid projects that contribute to the completion of their academic program.
2. Support of travel to conferences or workshops where undergraduate students enrolled in the Department of Geography are making oral or poster presentations.
3. Other extraordinary proposals of modest budget.

Conditions of the Grant

Undergraduate applications that involve participation in a larger research project will only be considered where it can be shown that they represent a discrete piece of work that contributes to the applicant's academic program.

Acceptance of a grant entails an obligation to use the funds in pursuit of the specified activity. No advances will be issued – all reimbursements will be given after the activity has been completed (original receipts required).

Category 1: A maximum of \$250 will be awarded to a student participating in an activity in British Columbia, Alberta, or Washington State.

Category 2: A maximum of \$400 will be awarded to a student participating in an activity outside of British Columbia, Alberta, or Washington State.
