POSITION AVAILABLE:

SJS 100, Introduction to the Theories of Social Justice - 1 Academic Assistant, 100 hours total. Rate of Pay \$27.65 per hour (effective September 2021). This class is scheduled to meet face to face on Tuesday from 5:00-7:50 pm. The TA must be available to attend every class.

This interdisciplinary, introductory course focuses on theories of social justice and is taught by one instructor from a cross-disciplinary perspectives (from the social sciences, humanities and human and social development perspectives). The class will examine the central theoretical frameworks utilized by scholars working in this diverse field. It will introduce students to key thinkers associated with social justice studies and develop a comprehensive and critical understanding of the concepts that these thinkers apply to social justice issues.

POSITION DESCRIPTION:

Under the supervision of the course instructors, the Teaching Assistant will do some or all of the following:

- 1. Track student attendance and participation
- 2. Help in the classroom, particularly with group discussions
- 3. Advise students on course content and assignments
- 4. Organize and facilitate group projects if assigned
- 5. Help with the Brightspace site e.g., posting of content and facilitation of out-of-class discussion.
- 6. Hold office hours by appointment
- 7. Grade short weekly assignments
