**Course delivery:** POLI 328 will be delivered on campus and face-to-face.

### **Course description:**

This course provides a survey of gender in an international relations context. We will examine the relationship between gender inequalities through the study of key concepts: power, violence, globalization, democratization, transnational feminism, and nationalism. Students will leave the course with a better understanding of gender, masculinities, feminisms, and the scope and method debates in the Political Science and International Relations.

### **Course outcomes/objectives:**

- Develop written and verbal communication through essay writing and discussion
- Explore debates in Feminist International Relations
- Understand the social construction of gender
- Understand how feminism is used as an analytical tool

Gender and the economy
