### FACULTY & UNIVERSITY REQUIREMENTS

In addition to the listed courses, you must satisfy all [requirements for the Faculty of Fine Arts](#), as well as complete at least 30 of the minimum 60 required units at UVic. Within these 60 units, **21 units must be upper-level (300/400-level) courses**, and 18 of those 21 units must be taken at UVic.

### ACADEMIC WRITING REQUIREMENT

If you've not already satisfied UVic's [Academic Writing Requirement \(AWR\)](#), you'll need to complete one of ATWP110, ATWP 135, ENSH 101, ENSH 102, or another approved course. Your program may also list one or more of these courses as mandatory requirements. See above.

### DECLARING YOUR PROGRAM

Request to declare your academic program at the end of first or second year.

Declared students have access to an online **degree evaluation (CAPP) report** for tracking graduation requirements.
