## FACULTY & UNIVERSITY REQUIREMENTS

Within these 60 units, 21 units must be upper-level (300/400-level) courses, and 18 of those 21 units must be taken at UVic.

## FOOTNOTES

1. Students **without** credit for Biology 12 or Physiology and Anatomy 12 must complete one of the following: EPHE 141 or BIOC 102 or BIOL 150A or BIOL 150B.  
  
Students with credit for Biology 12 or Physiology and Anatomy 12 must complete a Request for Change to CAPP form and take 1.5 units of additional elective.
2. HINF 202 must be taken prior to first co-op work term. Normally completion of all courses listed in first and second year will be required prior to undertaking the 1st work term.
3. Select 3.0 units from CSC 320/330/355/360, SENG 321; these must fit into the Fall and/or Summer terms and cannot include CSC 371.
4. Students are required to select a minimum of 6.0 units of senior electives must be at the 300 level or higher and include at least 3 units chosen from HINF, CSC or SENG. (\*excluding CSC 371)
