An intimate look at transgender singer Rae Spoon as personal and reflective as their songs. Alberta-born Spoon's story is set to a backdrop of stunning images of the Canadian Prairies.	
No dumb questions	HQ77.9 N6224 2009	A 2001 film by Melissa Regan. Uncle Bill is becoming a woman and his 6, 9 and 11 year old nieces are struggling to understand why and how. With just weeks until Uncle Bill's first visit as Aunt Barbara, the sisters navigate the complex territories of anatomy, sexuality, personality, gender and fashion. Their reactions are funny touching and distinctly different.	
A Normal Girl	Stream Here	Originally released as a motion picture in 2019 by Shawna Lipton and Pidgeon Pagonis. A Normal Girl brings the widely unknown struggles of intersex people to light, through the story of intersex activist Pidgeon Pagonis. 1.5% of people are born with anatomy that doesn't fit typical definitions of female or male. It is common practice for doctors to perform genital surgeries on intersex infants - often with disastrous results. .	


Paris is burning	HQ77.2 U6P335	The classic 1990 film by Jennie Livingston. A story of street-wise urban survival, gay self-affirmation, and the pursuit of a desperate dream -- to live for a brief, dazzling moment in a fantasy world of high fashion, status, and acceptance. Filmed between 1987 and 1989, Paris is Burning explores the world of New York drag balls and voguing competitions.	
Paradise bent	HQ77.2 S28P33	This 1999 film by Heather Croall examines the history and culture of Samoan men who chose to live as women, and how that institution has changed with modern western ideas of 'femaleness'	
Real Boy	HQ77.95 U6R43 2016	A 2016 film by Shaleece Haas explores the lives of a 19-year-old navigating early sobriety, late adolescence, and the evolution of his gender identity, his mother makes her own transformation from resistance to acceptance of her trans son. Along the way, both find support in their communities, reminding us that families are not only given, but chosen.	

Rural Transcapes	HQ77.95 C2R87 2012	A 2011 film Amy Bohigian film. Rural Transcapes is a topical film that profiles four transgendered individuals who have chosen to live in the rural area of the Kootenays.	
She's a boy I knew	HQ77.8 H38S535	A 2007 film by Gwen Haworth. Vancouver filmmaker Gwen Haworth documents her male-to-female gender transition partially through the voices of her family, best friend, and wife.	
Southern comfort	HQ77.95 U6S68	A 1981 film by Kate Davis. Toccoa, Georgia. Robert Eads is a 52-year-old wise-cracking cowboy who was born female and transitioned into living as a man after bearing two sons.	
Stand Together	Stream Here	A documentary from 2002 by Nancy Nicol on the lesbian and gay liberation movement in Canada between 1967 and 1987 focusing on the human rights amendment campaign in Ontario. It draws together a rich body of documents, images, and rarely seen archival footage	

		with dramatizations and interviews.	
Still Black	HQ77.95 U6S75 2008	A 2008 film by Kortney Ryan Ziegler. A documentary that explores the lives of six Black transgender men living in the United States through the intimate stories of their lives as artists, students, husbands, fathers, lawyers, and teachers.	
Tales of the waria	HQ77.95 I5T35 2011	A 2011 film by Kathy Huang. Indonesia is home to a community of transgender individuals known as warias, biological men who live openly as women. The film follows four characters from this little-known community as they search for romance and companionship, and uncovers a world that not only defies our expectations, but also reveals our endless capacity as human beings to search for love, whatever the consequences.	
Trans Clients Speak	HQ77.7 T72 2009	Recorded April 21, 2009 at California Institute for Integral Studies (CIIS), San Francisco. Four transgender panel members talk about their range of experiences with therapists: helpful, insulting, insensitive, uplifting, pathologizing, plaguing, empowering, and healing.

Transsexual Voyage	RC560 G45T73	A film from the 2000's by CBC showcasing four transsexuals telling their stories, including the reason for their coming to a premier Montreal sex change clinic.	
Transparent	HQ77.95 U6T73	A 2004 film by Jules Rosskam. Pink or blue. Male or Female. Mommy or Daddy. Categories that we all take for granted are blown wide open in "transparent," a documentary film about 19 female-to-male transsexuals living in the United States who have given birth and, in all but a few stories, gone on to raise their biological children.	
Two Soft Things, Two Hard Things	Stream Here	A 2016 film by Mark Kenneth Woods and Michael Yerxa, filmed on location in the Territory of Nunavut and the Province of Ontario, Canada. "As a small group in Nunavut, Canada prepare for a seminal LGBT Pride celebration in the Arctic, the film explores how colonization and religion have shamed and erased traditional Inuit beliefs about sexuality and family structure and how, 60 years later, a new generation of Inuit are actively "unshaming" their past.."

<p>What sex am I?</p>	<p>HQ77.9 W457</p>	<p>A 1985 film by Lee Grant. Follows a group of Transgender individuals struggling to make their way in every strata of 1980s America.</p>	
<p>Woubi Cheri</p>	<p>HQ76.2 C852A23 4</p>	<p>A film by Laurent Bocahut and Philip Brooks. This 1998 documentary shows a few days in the life of various members of Abidjan, Ivory Coast's gay and transgendered community</p>
