Bennett Issel (they/them) is the Dean's Assistant in the Faculty of Humanities at the University of Victoria. For the past two years, they have worked closely with the Dean, providing administrative support and managing her schedule. Prior to this role, Bennett worked in high-volume veterinary practices, specializing in administrative support and client care. Their experience in medical environments has helped them develop a calm and solutions-focused approach to challenges that may arise.

As a trans and disabled person, Bennett's goal is to create accessible and equitable support for staff, students, and faculty. They are continually learning and reflecting on their responsibilities as a guest on the unceded territories of the Ləkwəŋən and WSÁNEĆ peoples. Bennett has completed the Acumen training offered through IACE and the Indigenous Studies course *IS 100 – Responsibilities and Reciprocity in the Place You Are Now*.
