

I have been a faculty member in the Department of Mathematics and Statistics at the University of Victoria since 2016 and am currently an Associate Teaching Professor.

Throughout my time at UVic, my work has been guided by a commitment to the value of collegial governance and the desire to create meaningful opportunities for student success.

From 2018 to 2024, I was actively involved in the Faculty Association. I was a member of the bargaining team that successfully negotiated the 2022-2025 Collective Agreement. I have also been a member of several Associate committees, including the Executive Committee from 2020 to 2023.

Since 2024, I have served as Associate Dean Academic in the Faculty of Science. In this role, I have taken a leadership role in shaping the Faculty's approach to supporting both instructors and students. I currently chair the Faculty of Science Accessibility Committee, which coordinates Faculty-wide initiatives to reduce barriers to access in Science courses and supports instructors in managing the work associated with accessibility. In response to the rapidly evolving teaching environment, I initiated the Faculty of Science Community of Practice on Artificial Intelligence and Teaching in 2025.

I have been a member of Senate since 2023 and have served on the Senate Committees on Curriculum, Continuing Studies, and University Budget. Senate plays a vital role in shaping the academic direction of the University. I hope to continue serving on Senate in order to contribute to the collegial processes that make UVic an excellent place to learn, teach, and work.
