RE: Call for Nominations – Appointment Committee for Dean of Engineering
Nomination Deadline: Thursday, October 2, 2025

The term of the Dean of Engineering, Mina Hoorfar, will end on June 30, 2026. An appointment committee is being struck in accordance with Appendix B of policy GV0450. The policy may be viewed at [Procedures for the Appointment and Re-Appointment of Deans](#).

This is a call for nominations for one regular faculty member from each Electrical and Computer Engineering to serve on the appointment committee.

The nomination form is included in the email containing this memo, and can also be found under the voting tab on the Office of the University Secretary website. Those eligible to make nominations, to stand for election, and to vote shall be regular faculty members. If there is more than one (1) nominee an election will be conducted using Simply Voting. Nominees are invited to submit a brief biographical sketch and statement of candidacy (not to exceed 300 words and emailed to usec@uvic.ca). The election will open October 2, 2025 and close on October 7, 2025. **Completed nomination forms must be received at usec@uvic.ca not later than 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, October 2, 2025.**

Committee members must ensure they are able to attend all the committee meetings and are available to participate in interviews. The meeting schedule will include some or all of the following dates. Additional dates may be determined in consultation with the committee.

Where possible, alternates will be identified who may be asked to serve when a member needs to resign from the Committee before it begins to formally interview candidates. Alternates cannot be added after this point as each Committee member must be able to weigh the merits of each candidate prior to making a recommendation. 	Four (4) regular faculty members: One regular faculty member from each department. The faculty members are to be elected by regular faculty in their Department in an election conducted by the Office of the University Secretary.

1	Undergraduate student registered in the BEng or BSEng degree program in the Faculty of Engineering

1	Staff representative from the Faculty of Engineering with a continuing appointment. To be elected by and from all CUPE 951/PEA staff with a continuing appointment in the faculty and those CUPE 951/PEA staff working within the Faculty of Engineering, who have a continuing appointment outside the faculty, for whom at least 50% of their normal duties contribute to teaching, research or administrative duties in the faculty.
