ABOUT ME

I'm Evan Maher, a third-year Engineering student and re-elected Student Senator at UVic. Over the past two years, I've worked directly on academic policy, accessibility, and institutional accountability, serving on multiple Senate committees and engaging with senior administration. During my time on Senate, I've introduced three policy proposals aimed at improving equity and the student experience. I bring a systems-engineering approach to student governance and I believe student representation should be data-informed, independent, and should challenge decisions that do not serve the students' long-term interests.

OUR PLATFORM

The Student Leadership Alliance is a collective of students aiming to improve student representation at UVic and cooperate around a shared platform. We plan to:

- **Improve mental health and accessibility** - Challenging the unjust At-Risk Behaviour Policy (SS9125) so that it delivers fair, effective, and accountable mental health support for students.

Our plan: To pass an amendment to SS9125, to increase the duty of care from UVic.

- **Make campus more affordable** - Freeze parking rates, reduce markups on campus food, and end unfair course fees e.g., Brightspace, WebWork, and Pearson access.

Our plan: To amend the existing parking policy, and propose an additional policy around the pricing of student services provided by the University.

- **Ensure inclusive food access** - Expand halal and other dietary options within food services and extend the residence meal plan to be usable in the SUB.

Our plan: To pass a formal policy recognizing the existing Dining Advisory Committee, and granting it certain decision power over University Food Services.
