Nominees are invited to submit a brief biographical sketch and statement of candidacy (not to exceed 300 words and emailed to usec@uvic.ca). The election will open at 9:00 a.m. Wednesday, February 12, 2026, and close at 4:00 p.m. on Tuesday, February 18, 2026.

Nomination papers must be received by the Office of the University Secretary, Michael Williams Building, Room A138 or via email to usec@uvic.ca not later than 4:30 p.m. on Wednesday, February 11, 2026.
