

Gerald Singh is an Associate Professor and Ocean Nexus Chair in Global Change and Sustainable Development with the School of Environmental Studies at the University of Victoria. Singh is also the Deputy Research Director with the Nippon Foundation Ocean Nexus Center. His research is primarily situated in the science-policy interface towards sustainable development. This focus takes form in the following ways: 1) assessing cumulative anthropogenic impacts on the environment and understanding the consequences to people; 2) determine priority policy actions and plans to achieve specific sustainable development objectives; 3) understand risk and uncertainty in sustainability policy and management.

Gerald also researches the role of higher education in sustainable development, how academic policy affects equity and diversity, and how both can increase the relevance of higher education for societal benefits. He is eager to turn his research insights towards service by sitting on the University of Victoria Senate and contributing to the university's governance.
