- 1. TERM: The term of the Dean of Humanities, Dr. Annalee Lepp, ends on June 30, 2026.
- 2. POLICY: An appointment committee is being struck in accordance with Appendix B of policy GV0450. The policy may be viewed at <u>Procedures for the Appointment and Re-Appointment of Deans</u>.
- CALL: This is a call for nominations for <u>one remaining seat to be filled by a faculty member from one of the</u> <u>below departments</u> to serve on the appointment committee. The departments not listed below already have a faculty member on the committee.

- 4. FORM: The Nomination Form is attached to the original email. It can also be found under "Voting" on the University Secretary website.
- 5. SCHEDULE: Committee members must ensure they are able to attend all the committee meetings and are available to participate in interviews. The meeting schedule will include all of the following dates. Additional dates will be needed should the current Dean not seek re-appointment, requiring a search for a new candidate.
