

I joined the University of Victoria in 2014, and am currently an Associate Teaching Professor in the Department of Mathematics & Statistics. As manager of the Math & Stats Assistance Centre, I also have responsibilities with the Division of Learning and Teaching Innovation. I am keenly interested in accessible post-secondary education, and have served on my department's EDI committee as well as the Faculty of Science's EDI council, am faculty sponsor of our Association for Women in Mathematics student group, and served on the steering committee of the Academic Women's Caucus for several years. I also work frequently with K-12 teachers and students through various outreach activities, which contributes to improved diversity and inclusion in the sciences. My teaching practice largely centres on introductory (first and second year) courses, as well as a third year course on the History of Mathematics, which I redeveloped with the assistance of an Antiracism Initiative Grant to be more inclusive.

Through managing the Math & Stats Assistance Centre, I support students' transition into their first years of university mathematics; I also support this transition through the BC articulation committee for mathematics and statistics, for which I have been both Secretary and Vice Chair. I have served on a committee for the Office of the Registrar to update UVic transfer and admissions policies for revised 9-12 high school science curriculum, on the SEM implementation committee for Student Recruitment, Admission and Registration, and from July 2023 to June 2024 I was the President's designate on the Senate Committee on Planning. My time on the SCP has given me insight into Senate's processes, and made me a more useful member of my department's curriculum committee. I look forward to the opportunity to continue to support our University's tradition of collegial governance through service to the Senate.
