OUR PLATFORM

The Student Leadership Alliance is a collective of students aiming to improve student representation at UVic and cooperate around a shared platform. We plan to:

- **End Discrimination in Assessment** - Pass evidence-based policy that ensures assessment practices, including Universal Extended Time, do not disadvantage any students.

Our plan: To pass an assessment policy to address significant shortcomings of Universal Design Principles (UDL), and Universal Extended Time (UET) assessment practices at UVic.

- **Protect Student Access** - Halt the discontinuation of the physical ONEcard and oppose changes that reduce the accessibility or reliability of essential services.

Our plan: To reverse the amendment to the exam regulations policy that has resulted in the soon to be implemented discontinuation of the physical OneCard.

- **Restore Accountability in Governance** - Demand transparency, accurate data, and for administrative decisions to be informed by student-input.
